Attention: All Tax Assessor-Collectors

HB 2093, relating to enforcement of motor carrier registration and overweight and oversize permits, became effective September 1, 2007.

Under the legislation, the gross weight of a motor vehicle used to transport seed cotton (including equipment used to transport or process seed cotton) without having to purchase an overweight permit was increased to 64,000 pounds from 59,400 pounds.

Form VTR-815, Application for Cotton Vehicle License Plate, has been revised to reflect the increase. You should recycle any copies of the VTR-815 with a revision prior to 9/2007.
