

Exhibit Hall Fire Regulations

The information contained in this brief outline does not by any means cover completely the ordinances and regulations on fire prevention, but it does provide basic rules governing concession and exhibits in the Civic Center.

1. All curtains, drapes, or decorations must be non-combustible or flameproof.
2. Any merchandise or material attached to drapes or table skirts must be non-combustible or flameproof.
3. Fire extinguishing equipment needs to be determined by the Fire Marshall and any such equipment must remain visible and accessible.
4. Automotive vehicles and equipment may be displayed if:
 - a. There is not more than two gallons of fuel or the minimum amount for positioning.
 - b. Fuel tanks are locked and sealed.
 - c. Battery cables are disconnected.
 - d. Ignition keys are removed and at display location.
 - e. Vehicle operation is limited to brief parade type displays specifically approved by the Fire Marshall.
5. The use, display or storage of LPG, flammable liquid, or flammable gas must be approved by the Fire Marshall in writing.
6. NO SMOKING BY ORDER OF THE FIRE MARSHALL signs must be posted and maintained in areas so designated by the Fire Marshall; where smoking is allowed, non-combustible ash trays must be provided.
7. The use of open flames, burning or smoke-emitting materials as part of an act, display or show is prohibited.
8. The use of welding and cutting equipment for demonstration purposes must be by permit from the Fire Marshall.
9. The use of compressed gas cylinders must be approved by the Fire Marshall and cylinders must be firmly secured in an upright position.
10. The use of any gas fired appliance must be approved by the Fire Marshall, the use of salamander stoves is prohibited.
11. Sawdust and shavings shall be kept flameproof.
12. The storage of hay and straw must be approved by the Fire Marshall.
13. Electrical equipment must be installed, operated and maintained in a manner which does not create hazard to life and property.
